



In the Ladies' Tour competition, Belgian Lara Tadiotto has opened a two-stroke lead going into the final round.

Starting at the 10<sup>th</sup> tee, Tadiotto made birdies at the 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> but then dropped a stroke at 15 before picking up another birdie at the 18<sup>th</sup>.

The 33-year-old, who shot an opening round three-over-par 75, found the front nine far more difficult and had four bogies although birdies at the fourth and eighth enabled her to finish on level par 72, the best of the day.

Melodie Bourdy, of France, and England's Lora Fairclough are in joint second place, two strokes in arrears, after second round 73s, with Isabella Maconi, of Italy, the only other realistic challenger, a further stroke behind after a two-over 74.
