

## DEFENDING CHAMPION THAWORN WIRATCHANT



There have been many dominant golfers in the history of the MCB Tour Championship. David Frost and Paul Wesselingh are both two-time champions whilst 2015 winner Colin Montgomerie has never finished outside the top six. But when Thailand's Thaworn Wiratchant made his debut twelve months ago he went one step better in claiming a tournament-record eight-shot victory.

Opening rounds of 66 and 65 left the rookie tied for the lead alongside 2012 runner-up Peter Fowler, with Mark McNulty and Miguel Angel Martin in third and fourth. However the hopes of all three were laid to waste by a stunning burst of final round scoring. Wiratchant thrashed nine birdies and an eagle-3 at the final hole to equal the course record and complete a first win at senior level in just his seventh start.

The secret to the 51-year-old's success? "I felt really comfortable on the Legend course," he smiled. "It reminded me of playing in Thailand. My tee shots were great all week and that really helped me

win. I'm so happy. To claim victory in my first year is fantastic because there are so many good players here."

His playing partner Fowler admitted that he had been witness to something special. "Thaworn is just a magician on courses like these," he said. "He's played on them his whole life and it's no surprise. I've known and played with him for thirty years and he's majestic when he gets it going."

Wiratchant owns a record 18 victories on the Asian Tour so it was little surprise that he added this year's Sharjah Senior Golf Masters to his Staysure Tour tally. He was also the first round co-leader at the home of golf St Andrews in the Senior British Open in July. Do not be surprised if this confirmed winner completes a successful defence of his trophy.

## SENIOR MOMENT

### JEAN-FRANÇOIS REMESY

Frenchman Jean-François Remesy is enjoying his best year on the Staysure Tour since turning 50 in 2014.

Remesy, a three-time winner on the European Tour, secured his first over-50s title at this year's Swiss Seniors Open after carding an 11 under par total at Golf Club Bad Ragaz.

The 54 year old enjoyed his best years on the European Tour in 2004 and 2005, when he was a back-to-back winner of his home Open, the Open de France at Le Golf National, host venue of this year's Ryder Cup.

He would have to wait 13 years before his next taste of silverware, but he did it in fine style in Switzerland, finishing one stroke ahead of Miguel Angel Martin, Phillip Price and Jarmo Sandelin.

"The victory was confirmation of my ability to win tournaments. It was great to win again and the feeling I had on the green was one of freedom. We play a lot of tournaments, but we don't win a lot of tournaments.

"Whatever tournament it is, it can be a small tournament, a big tournament or an extremely big tournament, the feeling is the same - and it's good to have that sort of feeling.



"The win has given me the feeling of being able to compete again. The last four years were tough because I haven't really been in contention.

"Now whenever we play a new tournament I find myself looking at the leaderboard and seeing my name up there - it's a great feeling. "After his victory in Switzerland, Remesy then finished runner-up the following week at the WINSTON golf Senior Open and is set to end his season on the paradise islands of the Seychelles at the first-ever MCB Tour Championship-Seychelles event.

This will be the fifth time in a row the Frenchman will have had the opportunity to play at Constance Belle Mare Plage, and with the added stop of Seychelles on this schedule, there is some special significance for the Tour's first visit to the islands for Remesy.

"Mauritius has been one of my favourite destinations," he said. "Even before I turned 50, I've been visiting here for the last 20 years. The venue we stay at is incredibly special.

"Seychelles will be fantastic for all of us. I've been a resident there for seven years, and I've seen the golf course and the venue grow from nothing. So, to see Constance Lemuria host a professional golf tournament will be such a special moment for all of us - and it will be a fantastic place for us to finish our season."

With the number of events on the Staysure Tour increase, like his fellow professionals, Remesy is looking forward to seeing what the future brings both for the Tour and for the Indian Ocean Swing.

"I've really enjoyed it this year," he added. "We have had more tournaments to play in, new faces are joining us from the main Tour when they turn 50, so it's great seeing those guys again. The Tour looks very different to how it did a few years ago and we're all very excited to see how things will grow even further."

The MCB Tour Championship is undoubtedly the highlight of our season and leading up to it, our primary focus is getting the golf course ready. Our greens are luscious as ever, our bunkers are filled with fluffy sand and the fairways are awaiting the players! We continued in the same vein as last year to make constant improvements to both the Legend and the Links; the team has kept on thinning the bushes and general vegetation as this allows for better air movement through the course but also opens up the views for both the golfers and spectators to enjoy. Other works have been made behind the scenes that might not be visible to you, but they still make a big difference during your round of golf!

The Links, our 18-hole Championship golf course located just a swing away from the Legend, is also not to be missed. Created on ancient volcanic rocks and craters, you will be surrounded by endemic plants. Take the time to enjoy the view (and a cocktail!) from the Club House, but also visit our Golf Academy on either course. Our golf teachers are now equipped with a

FlightScope allowing us to calculate several statistics of your performance, which can help you improve your game on the long term. A holiday in the Indian Ocean means you leave with a nice tan, but with our help, you can also leave with a lower par!

If last year's tournament is anything to go by with the scintillating golf played by Thailand's Thaworn Wiratchant we have much to look forward to. His final round of 10 under par 62 equalled the all-time low round of the tournament and his overall score of 23 under was a new record winning score with a margin of eight shots. Truly amazing golf.

An easy short par 4 to begin with but care must be taken with the drive as there is water on both sides of the wide fairway. Most players may elect to play a long iron or a 3 wood which will still leave them a short iron shot to the green. This is a very real chance to start the round off with a birdie.



### HOLE 2 <

A challenging drive is required to a dogleg right tree lined fairway. The pin position will determine the real difficulty of the hole as the green is guarded by two large bunkers and a lake on the right to catch the, stray second shot.



### > HOLE 3

With the prevailing wind and a large sloping green, a good club selection will be needed to ensure par.



## HOLE BY HOLE

### > HOLE 4

A birdie chance for big hitters. The hole can be shortened by keeping the ball as far left as possible but beware of the water that protects both sides of the fairway. The green is guarded by three bunkers but a chip and a putt for birdie is very possible.



### HOLE 5 <

The most difficult hole on the course. A very straight drive is the only solution to avoid the water hazards and to set up a challenging long iron to a well protected green.



### > HOLE 6

A straightforward driving hole with water protecting the right-hand side of the fairway from the tee.

The green can be made in two but there is very little landing area and three bunkers lie in wait for the less than perfect shot. Normally a safe second with an iron played short of the green and a good pitch is the safest way to try and make birdie.

## FIRST TIMER DAVID SHACKLADY



Playing in his first season on the Staysure Tour, England's David Shacklady will take part in his first MCB Tour Championship this year.

Shacklady missed out at last year's Qualifying School, but made no mistakes in February as he secured his card for 2018. He has certainly made his mark on Tour after winning the VTB Russian Open Golf Championship August, and the 51 year old hasn't looked back.

"My season has gone better than I could have ever imagined," said Shacklady. "I set a target for the top 30, then top 25 and then Russia happened and it's all changed since then – I'm really pushing for the top ten this year.

"You always think you might be good enough, but until you get involved and try you don't know. Everyone told me that I was good enough, and that it would be a matter of time before I won – they were more confident than me.

"The older I've got I've played against younger people, so I haven't really played against people my own age until this year.

"You never quite know. You're in the last group against two proven players, but I felt calm. That was the biggest thing. The win is an amazing feeling, but doing it feeling the way I felt. Nerves weren't stopping me from thinking clearly or affecting my decision-making. It was a massive confidence boost."

So sure of his success this season, Shacklady booked his flights for the MCB Tour Championship at the start of the year. After his impressive performances throughout 2018, he also looks set to take part in the first MCB Tour Championship – Seychelles, the first-ever professional golf tournament on the islands.

"I've had the chance to work hard for five or six weeks before coming to Mauritius. I've never been here before, I'm so excited. My wife is here with me, I promised her that I'd make the top 50 so we booked our flights early – now I get the chance to stay in paradise for another week!"


